Operate in conformance with Attachment 23 of the Shipyard Phase 1 DDA, California Community Redevelopment Law, and all other applicable laws, rules and regulations regarding conflict of interest, public and open meetings, and public records. Transparency and accountability will guide all actions of the Legacy Foundation
